048/21 – FRAGO 002 - 2021 SPRING SUMMER TRAINING DIRECTIVE

1. Fragmentary Order (Frag O) 002 to 2021 Spring and Summer Training Directive can be found on SharePoint.
2. Due to the changing COVID-19 environment and with the anticipation of a third wave of infections, CJCR will cancel all in-person (overnight) training at Cadet Training Centres (CTC), Cadet Flying Training Centres (CFTC) and contracted flying schools. The focus will shift to delivering virtual training offerings, as well as in-person training / daytime activities where possible.
3. The Cadets and Junior Canadian Rangers (CJCR) remain committed to ensuring that Canadian youth have access to challenging and unique experiences. The current COVID environment will not permit the traditional overnight components that our Cadet Training Centres usually offer, however we remain committed to ensuring cadets still have unique training experiences through virtual training and the Cadet Activity Program (CAP).

049/21 – RELIABILITY STATUS REQUIRING UPDATES

Ref: NDSOD Chapter 4

1. Reliability Screening consists of conducting verifications and checks in order to be able to grant individuals a Reliability Status (RS), which is the minimum level required for all CAF members and civilian instructors working in support of the CCO. IAW ref, RS must be updated every 10 years.
2. Annex A contains a list of personnel who must renew their RS prior to the due date indicated, a list of personnel who have passed the RS update deadline and have been directed to cease all cadet activities including voluntary duty/support and a list of personnel who are authorized to return to duties as their RS has been approved.

050/21 – PRC/VSS REQUIRING UPDATE

Ref: CATO 23-04

1. IAW ref, all members shall update their Police Record Check/Vulnerable Sector Screening (PRC/VSS) every five years.
2. Annex B contains a list of personnel whose PRC/VSS will require renewal, personnel who have extended beyond the five year mark and have been directed to cease parading as well as personnel who are authorized to recommence duties.
3. Due to COVID-19, some police departments have changed procedures for processing of PRC/VSS (i.e. limited hours, suspended in-person services, etc). Therefore, if you require a PRC/VSS update, you are advised to call the non-emergency information line for the police department that has jurisdiction based on your place of residence and inquire about their current procedures. If you are unable to obtain an updated PRC/VSS due to the police department not currently conducting this service, advise rcsupacstaffing@cadets.gc.ca for further instruction.

054/21 – UPDATE TO RESERVE SERVICE/EMPLOYMENT FOR SUMMER 2021

Ref: Frag O 002 – 2021 Spring Summer Training Directive 25 Mar 21

1. With the release of ref, all overnight in-person cadet training activities have been cancelled for the summer of 2021. This includes all activities taking place at in-person Cadet Training Centres (CTC), Cadet Flying Training Centres (CFTC), and contracted flight schools. With the cancellation comes some changes in staffing opportunities for summer 2021. These opportunities include:

- a. Cadet Training Centres (Virtual) (CTC(V)): A number of a CTC(V)s will deliver a variety of virtual courses throughout the summer. Adults and Staff Cadets supporting CTC(V)s will work from their residence during the summer period. A

list of CTC(V) courses are available at Annex C. Applicants should indicate which course(s) they are interested in staffing. Exact dates for staff positions will be released as soon as they are known. Course dates have been included in the Annex;

- b. Summer Cadet Activities Program (Summer CAP): In-person activities delivered locally that do not have an overnight component. Activities will differ by community based on what staff and/or resources are available. More information about the Summer CAP will be released at a later date. Examples of types of Summer CAP activities could include:

- (1) Training related to the local training program,
- (2) Training related to all or part of a CTC / CFTC course that is not already captured in the CTC(V) list,
- (3) Training conducted by specialist instructors (sailing / SCOP clinics, expedition activities, marksmanship clinics, first aid training, etc.), and
- (4) Unique training opportunities available in the local community.

If you think you possess unique skills and / or qualifications and are willing to utilize those skills to deliver Summer CAP training in your local community, please indicate this on your application. Activities may be planned based on available staff with the requisite skills in a given community.

2. In the event that in-person training is cancelled due to the pandemic, staff who receive and accept an offer to support in-person training shall be offered the opportunity to either terminate their period of service / employment or to transition to supporting virtual training or Regional projects while working from home.

3. Interested adults are to submit applications using the Cdt #112 form, or by sending the information contained on the Cdt #112, to rcsupacstaffing@forces.gc.ca. Applicants who wish to amend their previous submission are encouraged to send an email to update their preferences.

 - c. What Authority, Responsibility and Accountability is in place in this scenario?
 - d. Would you consider a different action if there was a chance that others would find out about your decision?
 - e. What risk is there to the CAF / CCO / your corps in this situation?
